PROCESS OF FILING A CHECK:

- I. <u>"NSF" or "STOP PAYMENT"</u> -If a check is returned to you marked NSF (non-sufficient funds or stop payment):
 - 1. You must send a certified letter, return receipt requested to the maker, demanding payment.
 - 2. This letter MUST contain the language of the Texas Penal Code§ 31.06 (b)(3) (If you don't have a copy, please contact our office.)
 - 3. Either a signed green card, or the unopened envelope (please **DO NOT** open it) will be returned to you.
 - 4. 15 days after the date you sent the letter, bring or mail to this office:
 - a. The check.
 - b. A completed intake sheet (affidavit)-THE "FACTS ABOUT THE CHECK" BOX MUST BE COMPLETED.
 - c. A copy of the letter sent.
 - d. The unopened envelope or the signed green card.
- II. **ACCOUNT CLOSED** If the check is returned to you marked account closed:
 - a. Mail or bring to our office the check and the completed affidavit, ONLY.

We will send a postcard to the check writer to the address on the check and give them 10 days to pick the check up from our office. If we have a valid driver's license, we will at that time issue a warrant for their arrest.

Once you turn a check into this office, <u>DO NOT ACCEPT ANY PAYMENT</u> on the check, but direct the person attempting to make payment to our office. If you accept the money owed to you, you are responsible for paying the County Attorney's processing fee that is usually collected from the defendant. Thank you!

The paragraph listed above <u>MUST</u> accompany any additional information sent to the check writer in the certified letter.

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Re: New Procedure for Checks

Dear Business Owner,

In a previous session of the Legislature the Theft by Check presumption law was amended in a way that could greatly affect your business. Previously for the theft presumption to apply a merchant had to send a certified notice to the check writer advising him or her that the check had been returned and demand payment. The notice and demand law remains the same, as does the statutory language that must be included.

However, what has changed is that there is now an alternative method of notifying the check writer. You may continue to send the notices certified mail, or you may now send them regular mail, as long as there is executed an Affidavit of Service by Mail by the person actually sending the notice. (See enclosed). This affidavit will have to be signed in front of Notary Public and will need to be presented to this office with the check and a copy of the demand letter. If you wish to use the Affidavit of Service by Mail, please feel free to copy the enclosed form and use the copies in the future. I have also included a copy of the affidavit with explanations of what should be included in each blank as a guide in completing the affidavit.

PROCEDURE WHEN TAKING A CHECK

STRESS TO YOUR EMPLOYEES THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING ALERT WHEN ACCEPTING A CHECK!

IS THE CHECK PROPERLY DATED?

Checks must be dated the same day as given. Post dated checks can not be prosecuted.

IS THE SIGNATURE LEGIBLE?

Checks must be signed in your presence and should be checked with driver's license, date of birth, sex, race, weight, eyes and hair. Do not accept checks previously signed.

IS THE ADDRESS COMPLETE?

Require street address, not a post office box. Place of employment Both home and business telephone number.

DO WRITTEN AMOUNTS AND NUMBERS CORRESPOND?

Banks will not honor check(s) with discrepancies.

IS THE I.D. OF WRITER USED RECORDED?

The merchant must be able to identify the writer of the check.

Always require identification from the writer.

The most reliable identification is a driver's license or I.D. card with a physical description and/or photo Record the driver's license number and date of birth on check

Record other types of I.D. and I.D. number

HAS THE CLERK WHO RECEIVED THE CHECK INITIALED THE CHECK?

THESE ARE CHECKS TO AVOID

CHECKS WHICH ARE DIFFICULT TO PROSECUTE OR WHICH CANNOT BE PROSECUTED UNDER TEXAS "HOT CHECK" LAW:

- Post dated checks
- Checks that are more than two years old (generally if check is over one year old, (2) prosecution is extremely difficult).
- Checks which are received in the mail or left in receptacle. (3)
- Checks which do not identify who accepted it. (4)
- Checks which do not thoroughly identify the maker (5)
 - a) Verify pre-printed Driver's License number
- b) If none pre-printed, compare Driver's License and place I.D. facts on check in writing (make sure to include at least date of birth and driver's license number)
 c) Make a mark to indicate Driver's License photo comparison
- Checks not passed in this county
- Checks not presented to bank within 30 days of issuance
- Checks for which no 10 day notice was given by registered or certified mail. (8)
- Checks which are kept by the merchant more then six months from the date of issuance before being referred to the County Attorney's office.
- (10)Checks where ID does not match name of account holder printed on check
- (11)Stop-payment checks
- Check on out of state bank (difficult to prosecute) (12)
- Two party checks (13)
- (14)Person who took check cannot identify maker
